



## INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGY (ICT) 2022 DEVICE TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

### 2022 YEAR 7, 8 & 9

#### MIDDLE SCHOOL DEVICE PROGRAM: NOTEBOOK LEASING PROGRAM

Shalom College has implemented the Middle School Device Program to commence with Year 7 students in 2022. All Year 7 students will receive a College issued Notebook (details in the Notebook Leasing Package section below) for use in Year 7 through to Year 9.

Students will not be able to bring their own devices for Middle School - BYO devices are not supported.

### 2022 YEAR 10, 11 & 12

All Shalom College students entering Year 10 and continuing through to Year 12 will require a Notebook/MacBook for their senior studies. Parents can choose between one of the two following options;

***Please Note: The commitment to these programs is for the entire duration of the student's Senior Schooling at the College.***

#### OPTION 1: NOTEBOOK LEASING PROGRAM

Students opting for this program offered in Year 10, will receive a Notebook device that they will use for the duration of their senior studies until the completion of Year 12.

This program is designed to assist parents and students to obtain a Notebook device compatible with the Shalom network at a very competitive price.

Other advantages include:

- Provision of all learning areas and operational software
- Operating System Updates
- Dedicated IT Service Desk Support for both software and hardware
- The selected device is 'Ruggedized' with a 3-Year Warranty and includes a three-part per calendar year Accidental Damage Protection (ADP) program from HP (Hewlett Packard)

## End of the Notebook Leasing Program (Completion of Year 12)

- At the end of the Notebook Leasing Program, students are required to bring their Notebooks to the IT Dept. and for legal reasons, have their devices wiped of any College Licenced Software before taking ownership.

## Early termination of the Notebook Leasing Program (Students leaving Shalom before the end of year twelve)

- Students who leave the College before the completion of their studies in year twelve will be given the option of purchasing the notebook for the balance that is outstanding on their lease.

## OPTION 2: BRING YOUR OWN (BYO) NOTEBOOK

This program allows students to use their personal Notebook devices on the College Network for the duration of their senior studies.

Personal devices **must** meet the College's minimum operating standards and requirements outlined below:

- Device choice: Apple MacBook or Windows Notebook
- Operating System:
  - OSX minimum of 10.14
  - Windows 10 (Windows 10 Education Edition is Recommended)
- Screen Size: 11.6" - 15"
- Battery Life: 8 ½ Hours
- Software - purchase of all curriculum required software for timetabled classes is required
- Screen Mirror Support:
  - MacBook - Airplay Support
  - Notebook - Miracast Support
- Strongly Recommended: Ruggedized case to ensure the device is protected from accidental damage

Please be aware for the BYO Program there is:

- **Limited Shalom IT TECHNICAL SUPPORT AND NETWORK ACCESS**
- **BYO Notebooks do not have access to printing at the College**
- **Unable to install College Licenced Software onto BYO Notebooks**

## **Family Zone Year 7 - 12**

Shalom families have access to a Family Zone Family Pack, which covers 3 children and 6 devices. This is paid for by the school so there is no additional cost to parents. By setting up a private Family Zone account, you can apply age-appropriate parental controls on every device your child has access to, in any location.

We urge you to set up your family's account when you receive your activation email from Family Zone. Only by working together can we meet our digital duty of care - at school, at home, and everywhere in between.

## **2022 Notebook Leasing Package**

### **HP ProBook x360 11 EE G6 - Notebook/Tablet**

This model has a good performance to cost balance, it also has a damage-resistant record that is superior to others on the market. With the addition of HP's ADP, any accidental damage including screen breakages will be covered for the HP excess amount of \$60.50 instead of prices often over \$300.
