#### **Griffith Diplomas**

Griffith undergraduate diplomas give students a supported start to their university studies, helping the transition to a student's chosen bachelor degree.

Students can apply for Diplomas via QTAC. When you click into each program you can see the QTAC code for each Diploma + Bachelor. Please be aware that these are not stand alone, they are all packaged with a bachelor and each Diploma + Bachelor (and campus) combination has a unique QTAC code. We recommend putting these diplomas in that preference 5 or 6 slot as a back-up course. There will also be campaigns run to contact students who are not successful on getting a place directly into a Bachelor at Griffith to let them know about Diploma's as a back-up option.
