Bond University - Early Guaranteed Offer Scheme



Bond University's Year 12 Early Guaranteed Offer Scheme recognises the challenges students have faced over the past few years of senior schooling. Eligible students can receive an offer to study at Bond in 2023 before final ATAR results are released, providing certainty about future study options.

Complete Bond's direct online application, submitting results from Semester 1, Year 12 report and full Year 11 report. Applications are then assessed. If students are successful, they will receive a guaranteed offer. Offers guarantee entry to the relevant Bond program conditional on the completion of Year 12, and passing any prerequisite subjects. 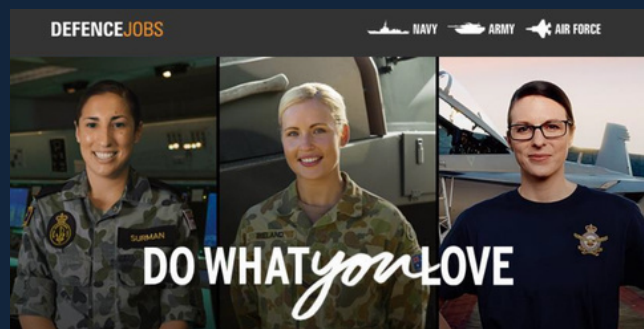
