## Tech Expo



66% of Australian 'digital workers' use digital technologies as a part of their work. Research indicates that this number will increase to 96% in only five years, encompassing workers from every sector and all levels of seniority. At the same time, Information and Communication Technology (ICT) career paths are becoming increasingly in-demand. In particular, data related occupations have more than doubled over the past five years.

So, it is vital to shift our perspective about who digital skills are for. While tech-based qualifications are often recommended for students looking at careers in IT, web development or cyber security, aspiring tradespeople, retail workers or entrepreneurs can't be excluded.

The brand-new virtual Tech Expo delivers career advice, employer exhibitors and additional resources, with a focus on gaining digital skills and exploring tech careers. Within the Expo, there are video interviews with successful Aussie tech CEOs such as Atlassian's Scott Farquhar and Tesla executive Robyn Denholm, as well as young people working in tech roles today.
