# INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGY (ICT) 2025 DEVICE TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

2025 YEAR 7, 8 & 9

## COLLEGE ISSUED NOTEBOOK PROGRAM - MIDDLE SCHOOL:

All middle school students will receive a College issued Notebook (details in the Notebook Program Package section below) for use in Year 7 through to Year 9.

Students will not be able to bring their own devices for Middle School - BYO devices are not supported.

2025 YEAR 10, 11 & 12

## COLLEGE ISSUED NOTEBOOK PROGRAM - SENIOR SCHOOL:

All senior students, by default, will receive a Notebook device that they will use until the completion of Year 12.

Families of Senior Students are provided the opportunity to opt out of the notebook program prior to the beginning of Year 10 or otherwise at enrollment.

Families who choose to opt out of the notebook program must commit to providing their student with a device for the duration of their senior schooling which meets the minimum device requirements as outlined under the 'BYO' section below.

Please Note: The commitment to the Notebook Program is for the entire duration of the student's Senior Schooling at the College. Once the device order has been placed, the ability to opt out will no longer be available.

This program is designed to assist parents and students to obtain a Notebook device compatible with the Shalom network at a very competitive price.

# Other advantages include:

- Provision of all learning areas and operational software
- Operating System Updates
- Dedicated IT Service Desk Support for both software and hardware
- The selected device is 'Ruggedized' with a 3-Year Warranty and includes a three-part per calendar year Accidental Damage Protection (ADP) program from HP (Hewlett Packard)

## **END OF THE NOTEBOOK PROGRAM**

## (YEAR 9 AND YEAR 12)

 At the end of the Notebook Program period, students are required to bring their Notebooks to the IT Dept. and their devices wiped of any College Licensed Software before taking ownership.

# OPT OUT: BRING YOUR OWN (BYO) NOTEBOOK

This option allows students to use their personal Notebook devices on the College Network for the duration of their senior studies.

Personal devices **must** meet the College's minimum operating standards and requirements outlined below:

- Device choice: Apple MacBook or Windows Notebook
- Operating System:
  - MacOS minimum of 11 (Big Sur)
  - Windows 11 (Windows 11 Education Edition is Recommended)
- Screen Size: 11.6" 15"
- Battery Life: 8 ½ Hours
- Software purchase of all curriculum-required software for timetabled classes is required
- Screen Mirror Support:
  - MacBook Airplay Support
  - Notebook Miracast Support
- Strongly Recommended: Ruggedized case to ensure the device is protected from accidental damage

# Please be aware when opting out of the College Notebook Program:

- BYO students will receive limited Shalom IT technical support.
- BYO students who require a loan device from the college (in the event of loss or damage of personal device) will be required to pay a weekly loan fee for the duration of the loan period.
- BYO Notebooks do not have access to printing at the College.

## **QUSTODIO CONTENT FILTERING AND PARENTAL CONTROLS**

Shalom families have access to a Qustodio Family Pack, which covers all college managed devices and up to 1 personal device. This is paid for by the school so there is no additional cost to parents. By setting up a private Qustodio account, you can apply age-appropriate parental controls on your student's school device, from any location.

We urge you to set up your family's account when you receive your activation email from Qustodio. Only by working together can we meet our digital duty of care - at school, at home, and everywhere in between.
