High School Photography Awards

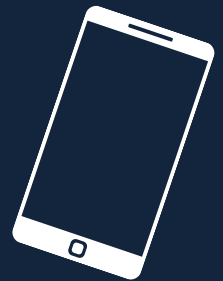


Calling all budding creative photographers! High school students from all over Australia are invited to enter and be recognised for their creativity and originality in the High School Student Photography Awards.
