# YEAR 9 \& 10 SUBJECT <br> SELECTION BOOKLET 2021 

Students will study a total of seven subjects each semester:

- Five Core subjects for the year
- One Humanities Core subject (History) for one semester
- Three elective subjects for one semester each.
- If electing to do Japanese, you will have to use two of your electives as it runs over two semesters


## What do I need to do?

1. Read Year 10 subject options in the Year 9 \& 10 Subject Selection Booklet
2. Select your Core Subject modules for English, Mathematics, Science and History
3. Select 3 electives you wish to study and 3 reserve electives that you would study if required. Japanese will count for two of your electives.
4. Using your Edval WebChoices link and code (you will be emailed) go online and make your subject selections
5. Submit the online form and email a copy to yourself
6. Print a copy of your completed form
7. Have your parent/carer sign the form indicating that they agree with your selections
8. Bring the signed form to Student Reception
9. Forms to be submitted by Friday $28^{\mathrm{th}}$ August.

## What else do I need to know?

1. Your Edval WebChoices link and access code will be emailed to you. Use this to access the Subject Selection Portal and select your elective subjects for 2021.
2. The Middle School Course Planner (page 24) is not required. This is a planning tool for you to use if you would like to.
3. The Middle School Off-line Subject Selection Form (page 25) is only to be used if you cannot submit your subject selections online using Edval WebChoices.
4. If you have any questions about the electives talk to your current subject teachers or the Learning Area Coordinator of the subject.

Select subjects by completing the semester module code in the spaces provided. When selecting subjects, follow the instructions supplied in the column on the left for both core and elective subject areas.
If you have completed an off-line subject selection forms must be submitted to Student Reception by Friday, 28 August 2020
Selection information: The study of core subject areas is compulsory for all students:

- Year modules are compulsory and preselected for Religious Education (REO1) and Physical Education (PEO1)
- Students must select an English, Mathematics and Science module to study for the entire year. For example: ENO2, MA03, SCO1
- One semester study of Humanities is compulsory (HUO1 or HUO2), further elective units can be chosen if desired
- Japanese as an elective studied for the entire year. Students electing to study Japanese in Year 10 must select IA01 twice in succession as it accounts for two of the four semester modules available
Only use this form if you cannot submit your choices online through Edval WebChoices.

Please note students can only select a maximum of two (2) semester modules from an elective subject area
