Families who choose not to opt into the Shalom College Laptop Leasing Program for students in years 10, 11 & 12 need to ensure that the following BYOD (Bring Your Own Device) requirements are met:

 - Windows 7,8 or 10 (Windows 10 Education Edition recommended)
- Screen size 11.6" 15"
- Battery life 8 hours
- Required Software: Purchase of all curriculum required software for timetabled classes is expected
- Screen Mirror Support
 - Macbook Airplay support

 Laptop – Miracast support (Supported by Windows 8 & 10, Laptop hardware needs to also support wireless display)
